- ECHO** equips families, missionaries, and development workers worldwide with sustainable solutions and innovative ways to combat hunger, malnutrition and poverty. Opening doors for sharing the gospel. Volunteers can work at our Global Research Farm in North Fort Myers on one or multiple days. Our work is never done!
Volunteer Opportunities with ECHO
 - » Seed bank: sorting and packaging seeds
 - » Farm work: weeding, harvesting, and planting
 - » Propagation: watering, weeding, and planting
- FCA of Collier County** establishes huddles (clubs) in schools to show the love of Jesus to student athletes. Faith + Sports = FCA: "To see the world impacted for Jesus Christ through the influence of Coaches and Athletes."
Volunteer Opportunities with FCA of Collier County
 - » Character Coaches: team chaplains for each sport
 - » Counselors for special events
 - » Staff support for summer leadership camp
 - » Assistance for annual banquet
 - » Support for summer football camp
- Good News Clubs** are after-school clubs held in local elementary schools. We share the Gospel message through lessons, verses, songs. 2 hours per week commitment; background check required; training provided.
 - » Bible teacher
 - » Song leader
 - » Registrar
 - » Game leader
- Helps Outreach** helps the poor and needy of Collier and Lee Counties by distributing food, clothing, furniture and miscellaneous items at no charge along with the Gospel of Christ. Training is provided for all volunteer positions. Short and long term volunteer opportunities. Opportunities for high school students too.
 - » Sort, stock and distribute food and household items
 - » Weekly Bible study leader
- Life Relaunch** restores men's hearts through discipling and deploying them to service in the local church, through a 2-day Life Relaunch experience led by a 5-8 man team. Training provided.
 - » Intercessory prayer
 - » Teaching
 - » Logistical support
 - » Technical support
- Mercy Ministry**, under the guidance of the Covenant Deacons, supports families and individuals in need with the goal of helping to transform lives and achieve self-sustainability.
 - » Advocate/mentor, meeting on an ongoing basis with those in need to provide advice and support towards attaining self-reliability
 - » Host family in the Better Together program
 - » Provide transportation to/from church and medical appointments for Covenant members
 - » Perform light home repairs for Covenant members
- New Horizons** works with at risk youth in elementary, middle, and high schools to help them reach their full potential through tutoring, mentoring, and faith-building. Most volunteers work one day, Mon-Thurs, for 2 hours after school with one child.
 - » Tutor and mentor elementary through high school students one or more days a week
 - » Teach a craft or skill to our 4th and 5th-grade girls or boys on Friday afternoon
 - » Share a career opportunity with the teens
 - » Help with Super Moms Club by teaching a skill to mothers or helping toddlers learn pre-K skills
- Nursing Home Ministry** ministers to the elderly in local nursing homes. Encouragement, love, and spiritual nourishment are shared with many who are lonely or forgotten.
 - » Friendship with regular visits to individuals
 - » Readers - of newspapers, short stories, etc.
 - » Pet owners bring gentle pets
 - » Play games, cards etc.
 - » Family visits with children
- Place of Hope** reclaims and molds discarded children into successful leaders to change Haiti.
 - » Prepare newsletter mailing 4x annually
 - » Annual school supplies/clothing drive, sort & pack
 - » Annual Christmas backpacks, prep, pack, ship
- Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC)** exists to glorify God by intervening in the lives of women facing an unplanned pregnancy in order to save the life of the unborn and transform the lives of the mothers.
 - » Train to be a male Coach or female Advocate who meets with patients facing an unplanned pregnancy
 - » Host a PRC baby shower
 - » Drive patients to a clinic and/or class
 - » Serve once a week to organize and/or clean offices
 - » Host a coffee in your home to introduce PRC to others in your community
- Storytellers Creative Arts** heals and transforms the lives of the underprivileged, addicted, disabled and at-risk with the love of Christ through a unique combination of the arts and faith. Volunteer opportunities are Monday-Saturday, morning, afternoon or evenings.
 - » Artists in all areas and levels: visual arts, musicians, storytellers, vocalists, actors, etc.
 - » Group facilitators to lead bible discussions and group activities
 - » Arts Instructors to lead and direct arts projects in outreach groups
 - » Support volunteers: administrative, supplies, drivers, refreshments, etc.
- St. Matthew's House** changes lives in a faith-based environment that is both compassionate and disciplined as we provide housing for the homeless, food for the needy, and comfort for the addicted and suffering.
 - » Kitchen assistance or administrative support
 - » Serve holiday or weekly meals at Justin's Place
 - » Help retail staff and stock merchandise at one of five thrift store locations
 - » Mentorship
 - » Pack groceries and organize food pantry shelves
- The Timothy Initiative** is an international church planting movement that trains, disciples, and deploys indigenous church planters to reach their own unreached people through disciple multiplication
 - » Journalist to chronicle stories from the field
 - » Intercessory prayer partner
 - » Manage content continually coming from the field
 - » Assist with data research projects
